ENJOY THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Grant County features spectacular scenery around every corner. Two natural wonders create miles of scenic coastline along the edge of Grant County. The Wisconsin River to the north and the Mississippi River to the west can provide hours of entertainment while tubing, kayaking, boating, fishing or swimming. From the riverfront to the backwaters, Grant County is filled with creeks and streams, too - including over 100 miles of world class trout streams.

Grant County is nestled between the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway and Upper Mississippi flyway, where you're sure to find a variety of wildlife on the land, in the trees or across the sky. Trekking through the parks, you'll discover a deep mining heritage, Native American burial mounds, caves, fossils and more. Take a scenic drive and plan to stay a while and explore.

Biking

Whether you prefer a road route, paved trail or uneven ground, Grant County offers a wide variety of terrain for biking on over 500 miles of trails and routes.

Bird Watching

Bordered by two significant riverways, Grant County is an excellent location to track migratory birds.

Disc Golf

Fishing

Grant County's trout streams attract anglers from near and far. Several accessible rivers as well as their tributaries provide excellent trout and bass fishing. The Mississippi and Wisconsin Rivers offer opportunities to catch catfish, panfish, walleye, northern, sturgeon and more.

TAKE A STEP BACK IN TIME

Grant County has a deep history - literally! We're home to The Mining and Rollo Jamison Museums in Platteville. This is your chance to go underground and tour an actual lead mine used in the 1800s. You might also notice Platteville's giant M just to the east of town - which stands for Mining! On the surface, the railroad played a major part in developing communities around Grant County. Its history is told through the Boscobel Depot Museum and Fennimore Railway Museum. Interested in seeing how far the Ag industry has advanced? Then plan a trip Stonefield Historic Site in Cassville and visit the Wisconsin State Agricultural Museum. Or, go even further back in history, and check out the mounds built by indigenous peoples that are located along the Lower Wisconsin Riverway.
